Liam sings traditional folk songs from his native Lincolnshire, accompanying himself on melodeon and concertina. In recent years Liam has taken the music, song and dance of his native county around the world performing in North America and Europe, as well as across the UK. Liam's work has been described as "breathing new life into the songs".

As well as concert performances of Lincolnshire folk songs, Liam is also a highly regarded dance caller, MC and workshop leader, having appeared at many festivals and dance events around the world. Experienced working with community groups, schools, universities and social clubs, he inspires and entertains people of all ages and abilities.

Workshops: A wide range including beginners long-sword, songs for children, melodeon, playing English dance music and many more.

Dance Calling and MC'ing: Liam has worked with a diverse range of bands on the festival and ceilidh circuit and is also a popular concert MC.

Presentations: "Dancing the Small Halls", uses video footage from his year long research project. Liam reflects on the nature of small community folk dance events in Europe and North America and what we can learn from them.
